Prof. Richard L. Baron



Richard L. Baron is Professor of Radiology and Dean for Clinical Practice in University of Chicago Medical Center, Chicago - USA. He has also been chairman of Radiology in this medical center.

He received his medical degree in Yale University and the postgraduate training in Yale University (internal medicine), Washington University School of Medicine St. Louis, Missouri. Mallinckrodt Institute of Radiology (Resident in Radiology and fellow in abdominal radiology).

He has numerous awards, including the American Board of Radiology's Distinguished Service Award and multiple Magna Cum Laude Awards from the Radiological Society of North America and the Roscoe Miller Award from the Society of Gastrointestinal Radiologists.

His researches on diagnostic imaging of liver disease are very powerful and Dr. Baron is an international authority on imaging in chronic liver disease and liver tumors. He is the author of more than 150 peer-reviewed articles and abstracts, and 27 book chapters on radiology and the diagnosis of gastrointestinal cancers.

Dr. Baron, nowadays, serves on the Board of Directors of the Radiological Society of North America. International Society of Radiology and since 2009 is member of Global Steering Group on Education and Training Diagnostic Imaging in the World Health Organization (WHO).

Dr. Baron has been visiting Professor in many universities and clinical and medical schools.

He has received recognition worldwide with multiple international honorary memberships and now, SERAM has the honor of been one of them.

Maximilian F. Reiser is profesor of Radiology of the Department of Clinical Radiology at Ludwig Maximilian University of Munich and Dean of Munich University Medical Faculty.

He also has been professor and chair of radiology at the University of Bonn.

He received his medical degree from Dean Munich University, Medical Faculty and completed his residency also in Munich at the Technical University.

He has been visiting professor in University of Vienna, Stanford University, Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, New York, NY and University of Vienna.

Between 2010- 2011 was President of ESR (European Society of Radiology) and nowadays is Examiner's Certificate as examiner of the European Diploma in Radiology Chairman of the scientific committee of the European Board of Radology (EBR).

His main topics are skeletal radiology, abdominal and MR imaging, cardiac imaging, oncologic interventions and Dr. Reiser has published more than 700 publications.

He is Member in Executive Committees of European Society of Radiology, German Radiological Society (DRG), International Skeletal Society, European Society of Magnetic Resonance in Medicine and Biology European Society of Musculoskeletal Radiology, German Society of Osteology.
