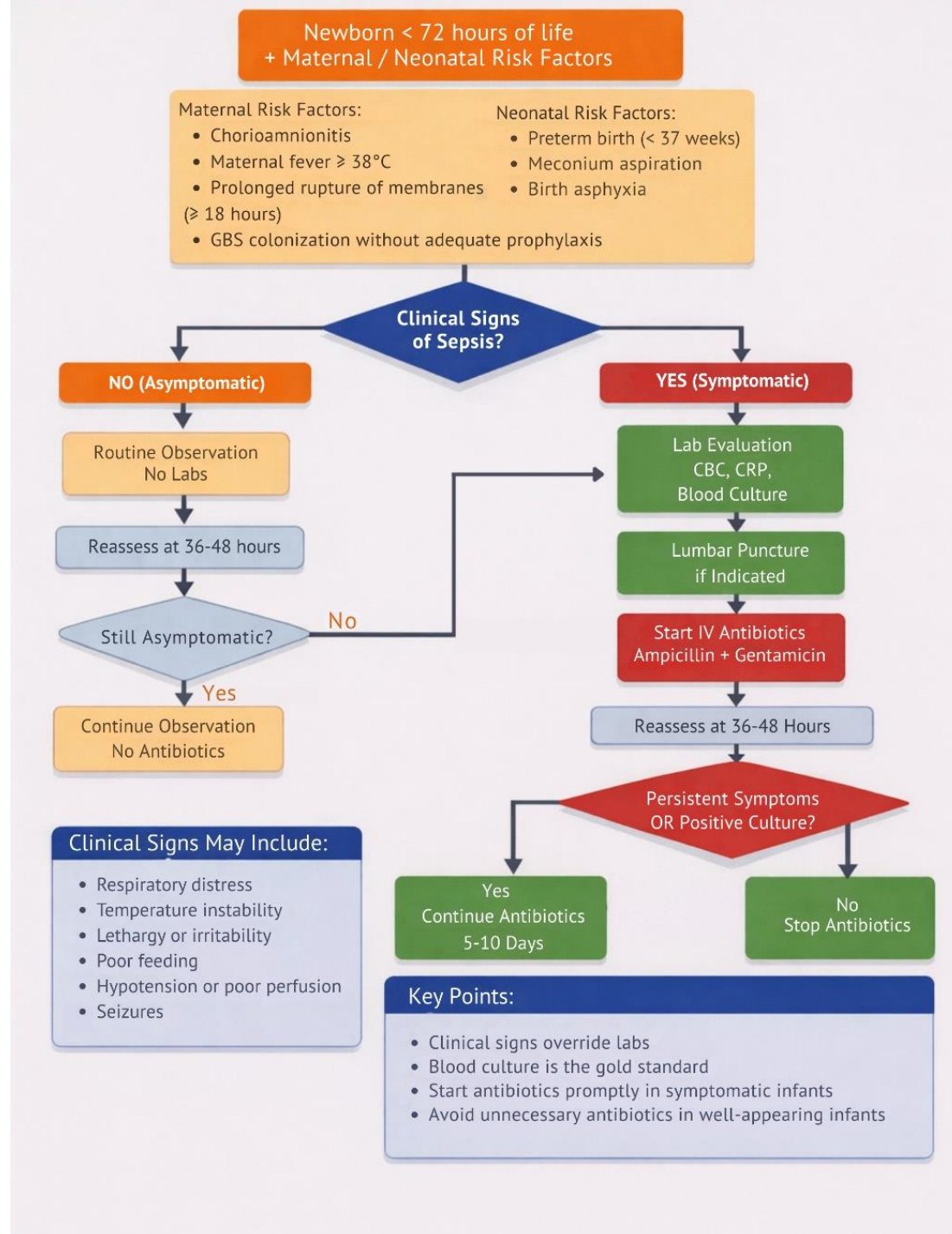


Early-Onset Neonatal Sepsis (EOS) ≤ 72 h

(Late Preterm & Term)

Definition: EOS is the isolation of pathogenic microbes from blood or spinal fluid culture occurring ≤ 72 hours of life, usually acquired from the mother.



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
